## COMPATIBILITY & INTENDED USE

The TigerMoth Headlight is intended for commuting, casual riding, and running errands. It is not intended for aggressive off road use, downhill or extreme riding, or racing. It features a versatile, tool-free mount with a swivel, so you can mount it on handlebars or frame tubes up to 35mm in diameter, fork, or helmet.

## INCLUDED PARTS

- 1 Headlight
- 1 Tool-free mount
- 1 USB charging cable

## INSTALLATION

- Wrap the rubber mounting strap around the part of the bike you wish to mount the light to, or your helmet. The arrows on the mount should point toward the front of the bike or helmet.
- 2. Pull the strap taught and slip the closest hole in the strap over the hook on the mount. The strap should be just tight enough that the light cannot move freely and will not slip if you go over a bump.
- 3. Slide the light onto the mount until it snaps into place.
- 4. Finalize the angle of the light by using the swivel and by rotating the mount.
- To remove the light from the mount, depress the button on the side of the mount and slide the light off. To reattach, just slide it back on until it snaps into place.

## USE

**NOTE:** You must charge the light fully before first use. Initial charging may take up to five hours. The light ships in a locked mode to prevent damage to the battery while in transit or on display. To unlock the light, press the on/off button continuously until the button turns blue.

The light features four modes: high, medium, low, and flashing.

- 1. To turn the light on, press the on/off button once but don't hold down.
- 2. To switch from one mode to the next, press the button once.
- 3. To turn the light off while in any mode, press and hold the on/off button for two seconds.
- 4. To enter flashing mode, press and hold the on/off button for three seconds.
- 5. The on/off button indicates how much of the battery's charge is remaining:
  - a. Green: 15-100%
  - b. Red: 0-15% (needs charging)

## LOCK

- Lock the light by holding the on/off button for six full seconds. Light will enter flashing mode, then turn off. The light is now locked.
- 2. To unlock, hold the button down until the indicator color changes from red to blue. Upon release, the light will turn on and is ready for normal use.

### CHARGING

- To charge the light, plug the charging cable into the USB port on your computer and into the back of the light.
- 2. When the on/off button changes from red to green, the light is fully charged and ready for use.
