TOOLS REQUIRED

#1 Phillips screwdriver for battery installation

INTENDED USE

To make the cyclist more visible in low light riding scenarios.

COMPATIBILITY

Fits handlebar diameters of 21.7mm to 31.8mm.

INSTRUCTIONS

Wrap the tail of the light around the handlebar and attach to tab (Fig. 1). Ensure the complete rubber tail is installed under the lip of the tab mount.

FUNCTIONS:

Click once - Steady ON

Click again - Flash

Click again - Strobe (quick double flash)

Click again - OFF

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

Unscrew the battery cover using a #1 Phillips screwdriver. Gently remove both batteries and replace them with two new CR2032 model button cell batteries. Be sure to install the new batteries with the (+) facing outward.

BATTERY WARNINGS

A coin-cell, lithium-ion battery is used in this device. If these guidelines are not followed, batteries may experience a shortened lifespan or may present a risk of damage to the device, fire, chemical burn, electrolyte leak, and/or injury.

- Do not leave the device exposed to a heat source or in a high-temperature location, such as in the sun in an unattended vehicle. To prevent the possibility of damage, remove the device from the vehicle or store it out of direct sunlight, such as in the glove box
- Do not disassemble, modify, remanufacture, puncture or damage the device or batteries
- Do not immerse or expose the device or batteries to water or other liquids, fire, explosion, or other hazard
- · Do not use a sharp object to remove the batteries
- KEEP BATTERIES AWAY FROM CHILDREN

ONGOING MAINTENANCE

Periodically inspect the mounting tab and rubber mounting strap for damage. Periodically make sure your light is securely mounted and in working order with fresh batteries.
